

# A VIEW FROM THE HORNET

#### **JUNE, 2025**

We are on the road again in Southern Oregon. So, this edition might be a little abbreviated. On the way we drove past beautiful Mt. Shasta at 14,160 ft. and it was still covered in snow on a bright sunny morning.

As I mentioned in my last issue, I had been contacted by Dr. Matthew Fash, the National Coordinator of the United States Navy Memorial Stories of Service Program and Student Interview Program. This year, one of their East Coast schools visited the USS New Jersey, interviewed Veterans, and created short documentaries to Honor, Recognize, and Celebrate the men and women of the Sea Services, past, present, and future; and to Inform the public about their service. One of their West Coast schools St. Vincent De Paul College Prep High School, is near the USS Hornet, and he wanted to arrange a visit for their student team to work on the same project that their East Coast team just completed.

I managed to have five former crew members, including myself, attend the event. Ted Kolda, Tim Wilson, Larry Silva, Dale Berven and me. The student team interviewed each of us at our former duty stations and encouraged us to share our experiences and reflections from our time on the USS Hornet. Suffice it to say, these young high school students, both boys and girls, inspired us with their attentiveness, interesting questions, and just great behavior. They took notes as well as videos of the event. They all thanked us, shook our hands and seemed to have truly enjoyed their day on the Hornet. #### Big news from the Museum's Air Group

Last month, the USS Hornet Museum finally acquired an F/A-18 Hornet. It arrived from Pensacola, FL. courtesy the United States Air Force onboard a massive Lockheed C-5 Galaxy, arriving at Oakland's International Airport. The F/A-18 was loaded on a flatbed truck and brought to Alameda where it was lifted on to and welcomed aboard the museum. This very F/A-18 is historically celebrated as being in the Gulf War in 1991 and recorded the very first "kill" of a MiG-21 on the opening day of the conflict. It will now spend several months being meticulously restored by our volunteer aircraft restoration crew before being officially added to our other aircraft displays. June 14, Night Ops: Live-Aboard Overnight Adventure





For those who choose to arrive early or stay late, the same room rate is available 3 days before and 3 days after the official reunion dates, <u>based on availability</u>. You may need to call MRP (number below) for assistance if you wish to come early or stay late.

The published hotel check-in time is 4pm. You may cancel up to 72 hours prior to arrival without penalty. 


