Tuesday, October 6: (10:00am-4:00pm)

Do as much—or as little—as you like: cast a line fishing, play horseshoes or corn-hole, hop on an ATV ride, or simply relax and take in the nature around you. As the day winds down, we'll gather for a hearty cowboy BBQ feast with brisket, chicken, and all the fixin's. This day was a HUGE HIT last time — so come on out and let's get country!

HISTORIC SAN ANTONIO AND THE ALAMO EXPERIENCE

Wednesday, October 7: (10:00am-3:00pm)

Board your luxury motor coach for a day steeped in Texas history. Your local guide will provide historical perspective and answer questions on your way to visit the "Queen of Spanish Missions", Mission San Jose. Enjoy a documentary film and explore the sacred grounds. You will then venture to Alamo Plaza to experience the award winning IMAX movie presentation of "The Price of Freedom", which chronicles the story of the battle of the Alamo. With fresh images and the story in your mind, proceed to the Alamo itself. See where it all actually happened and walk the hallowed grounds of history. You will have time to visit the Alamo and have lunch on your own and souvenir shopping around the Alamo Plaza before returning to the hotel. Please wear comfortable walking shoes, bring water, and your camera

SUPRISING SAN ANTONIO CITY TOUR

Thursday, October 8: (9:00p-2:00p)

Welcome to an amazing San Antonio City Tour, a relaxed and scenic journey through the city's rich past and vibrant present. Our route includes historic and cultural landmarks such as Plaza de Las Islas, City Hall, the Spanish Governor's Palace, Market Square, La Villita, the King William Neighborhood, Mission San José, and Mission Concepción.

One of our most popular stops will be the famous San Antonio Shoe Factory (SAS Shoes), one of the few remaining shoe factories in the US still making footwear by hand. Visitors see skilled shoemakers crafting shoes one at a time, using a meticulous process that can involve up to 100 steps and dozens of artisans. Guests watch leather cutting, stitching, shaping, and finishing — a rare look at old-school American manufacturing. After the tour, guests can explore the SAS General Store, styled like an old-fashioned country shop, with Vintage displays, snacks and treats, A full selection of SAS shoes. It's consistently described as a fun, nostalgic stop even for people who aren't shoe shoppers.

We'll make a brief 20-minute stop at San Fernando Cathedral to visit the geographic center of San Antonio, followed by a longer stop at Market Square—the largest Mexican market in Texas—where you can enjoy food, drinks, and shopping. A nice relaxing and fun day for everyone!

COWBOY SUPPER & ENTERTAINMENT AT THE KNIBBE RANCH

Thursday, October 8: (3:30p-7:30p)

Kick back with a cold drink on the bus ride to a 5th-generation, 1,000-acre working cattle ranch—hailed as “the most beautiful, authentic ranch-style entertainment facility in South Texas.” Upon arrival, climb aboard a trailer with our host to explore a 6,000-year-old Native American dig site and historic buffalo jump. Next, roll straight into the cattle herd for an insider’s look at the Texas cattle business, then head to the paddock to see live steers up close and learn their role in Texas heritage. As the sun sets, strap on your feed bag for a cowboy BBQ feast of brisket, grilled chicken, and all the fixin’s. The night caps off with live western entertainment—a truly authentic Texas evening you won’t forget!

SPECIAL OFFER: USS LEXINGTON DAY TRIP

Friday, October 9: (8:00am-4:00pm)

A day trip by bus from San Antonio to the USS Lexington Museum in Corpus Christi is both scenic and historic. The ride itself takes about two and a half hours, passing through the rolling landscapes of South Texas before arriving at the Gulf Coast. Known as “The Blue Ghost,” the USS Lexington is a World War II aircraft carrier with 3,000 sailors that earned its nickname because Japanese forces reported sinking her multiple times, only for the ship to reappear in battle. Today, visitors can explore over 11 decks, including the flight deck with vintage aircraft, a 3D Mega Theater, and even a flight simulator. Fun fact: the Lexington was commissioned in 1943 and served longer than any other Essex-class carrier, finally retiring in 1991. A bus trip makes the visit easy and social—perfect for groups who want to enjoy the ride together, swap stories, and then spend the day walking through living history on the decks of a ship that once carried 3,000 sailors. A hot Lunch is included on-board! (Note that this tour gets back at 4pm and our final banquet dinner at the hotel is at 6pm)

GRAND RIVERWALK BARGE CRUISE

Friday, October 9: (10:15am-12:30pm)

The famous River Walk has a new extension, and we will embark on private, charter boat ride of the entire river walk area, including the newly opened *Arts Section*. Sit back and spend a couple of hours enjoying a fully narrated tour of the sights and sounds of San Antonio’s most popular attraction, including the new “locks” system. Afterwards, you’ll have free time to explore the infamous Alamo and have lunch on your own on the famous River Walk. Note capacity is limited – book soon!
